

Location:

The Spring Bank Community Centre is within the Central Ward, North Area, at the heart of a vibrant multi-cultural community covering Spring Bank and Beverley Road. The Centre is located within the Spring Bank Conservation Area surrounded by a mix of rented and private housing and set back from a row of small independent shops and offices. The Centre is approximately 1 mile north west of the City Centre.

Accommodation:

The property is a purpose built single storey Community Centre with large hall, meeting rooms, WC'S, kitchen facilities, plant room, storage and own enclosed front car park.



Utilities / Services:

Water, electricity and gas supplies to the property as well as a telephone line. The Centre has gas central heating to most of the accommodation. (Note: Initially, there maybe some financial assistance (up to 50%) of the costs of the utilities from Hull City Council but the tenant will be expected to become fully self funding in due course).

Planning

The property falls within Class F2 of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) (Amendment) Regulations 2020. Any interested applicants should make their own enquiries to satisfy their planning requirements.
